Romans 3:23 says that we are all sinners who have fallen short of God's righteous standard. How do we know if we are all sinners? We have all broken one or more of God's Ten Commandments. Like a criminal who has broken the law, we deserve to be punished for breaking God's laws. Before a holy God, just one sin requires the death penalty. This is how seriously God hates sin. **Romans 6:23** says that the "wages of sin is death", meaning eternal punishment and separation from God. We cannot pay for our sins by our own personal effort or good works because we sin so frequently. Fortunately we can escape the death penalty and receive forgiveness. We can receive eternal salvation as a free gift (**Ephesians 2:8-9**). Jesus came to pay our penalty for sin once and for all. Jesus died on the cross and redeemed us through His blood so that we may have eternal life as a free gift. Our response is to believe & receive Christ in faith (**John 3:16-17**).

UNDERSTAND THE GOSPEL

1. WE ARE ALL SINNERS & OUR SINS SEPARATE US FROM GOD

Romans 3:23 - For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

2. THE WAGES OF SIN IS DEATH

Romans 6:23 - For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

3. WE CANNOT PAY THE PRICE FOR OUR SINS WITH OUR OWN EFFORT / OWN RIGHTEOUSNESS

Isaiah 64:6 - We have all become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous deeds are like a polluted garment. We all fade like a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, take us away.

4. GOD LOVES YOU AND HAS A REDEMPTION PLAN FOR YOU

John 3:16 - For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

5. JESUS PAID OUR DEBT FOR SIN THAT WE COULD NOT PAY

Isaiah 53:5 - But He was wounded for our transgressions; He was crushed for our iniquities; upon Him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with His stripes we are healed.

Mark 10:45 - For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.

6. JESUS CHRIST IS THE ONLY WAY WE CAN RECONCILE WITH GOD

John 14:6 - Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

1 Timothy 2:5 - For there is one God, and there is one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus,

7. REPENT (CHANGE YOUR MIND) & RECEIVE JESUS CHRIST TODAY

John 1:12 - But to all who did receive Him, who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God,

Acts 16:30-31 - Then he brought them out and said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?"
31 And they said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household."

Romans 10:9-10 - Because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.
